If you have a package being delivered from Amazon, you can have it delivered to a pick-up location instead of your home. There are multiple locations for our area, but three I found in our immediate vicinity are:

Smokestack - 1717 Northwest Highway, at 7-Eleven, Garland, TX, 75041-5234

Page Call Wireless - 1402 Northwest Highway, Suite 105 B, Garland, TX, 75041

Phone Crush Repairs & Accessor - 4301 Saturn Rd, Unit 215, Garland, TX, 75041

I've never used any of these locations, but I have used this option elsewhere. A minor inconvenience for having to stop and pick up your purchases vs the risks of losing your purchase to a thief!! For other retailers, I know they have their own pick-up services at their location even while offering home delivery. I personally have never had anything stolen from my porch, but the Next Door app posts these types of notices all the time. Security for devices · Another 'Tis the Season' helpful hint. A lot of people shop on-line, social media, phone. Here are helpful suggestions you might consider (if not already doing so): · Never install unapproved software · Verify attachments are safe before downloading · Verify links before clicking · Secure your devices when not in use (lock your phone/computer) · Create and use strong passwords o Helpful hint – make your password a sentence that you would remember and then use first letter of each word § Sentence example – I work at IDX in Dallas TX-14303 · Iw@IDXnDTX-14303 (example made up for this article) § Use a sentence that means something to you and would be easier to remember § You should never use 'regular' words or names found in a dictionary. A hacker's device can easily determine what your password is. Stay safe out there and do what you can to protect your identity!
