
#### HAPPY SUMMER

This community is full of so many unique individuals from all walks of life and I feel blessed to have met the ones I have. How lucky are we to live in such a beautiful neighborhood full of individuals with the same taste in Square Footage! I can't wait to meet more of y'all and hope that if you see me and the hounds on our walks that you will say hello, we would love to introduce ourselves (The dogs are harmless, they are just really big!). On that note I also wanted to give a few summer tips for other pet owners, like myself, for the upcoming weather changes that come with a hot Texas summer.  $\Box$  It's getting HOT, can you imagine being covered in fur on top of it?! Keeping your pets in shade or AC will help keep them cool in the heat and help them regulate their body temperature along with LOTS of water 
Timing walks: The concrete can get up to 10 degrees hotter than the air at the hottest times of the day meaning that morning and evening walks tend to be the best times. 
Mosquitoes: They are everywhere and they don't discriminate! Don't forget to give your pups their monthly dose of heartworm prevention. (If you don't know what I mean when I say that I'd love to recommend a few local vets for you to check out!) Happy summer, from your neighbors at "Bears House". Cheers!

### Understanding the Sprinklers By Sheila Raines

To understand how the decision to water our yards is decided, I have gathered some information to share. Our sprinkler system is controlled and maintained by the HOA. It is a rather complex system for 175 yards, 6 control boxes and 6 electric meters. The landscape man, Randy is the only one that really understands the layout which involves a current system as well as an older system that is still in the ground but not used. That is why you might see some sprinklers in the yard not working since they are the old system. In the spring you can see the crew checking every sprinkler head for needed repairs from the winter freezes and regular maintenance This service takes several weeks in preparation of turning on the sprinklers along with the regular maintenance of the yards, mowing, edging and trimming. To decide when to water, the HOA uses the Water Awesome App. If it rains, we do not water! We do our best to conserve water as it cost approximately \$800 to do one sprinkler run and if ran twice a week the cost would be approximately \$6400 a month for water bill. To give you an idea of the water cost for the year in Towngate neighborhood, year 2021 was \$13,329 while in 2022, the water cost was \$19,692. This cost also includes the maintenance of filling the pools.

Our sprinkler system was not designed to water the foundations so it is up to each homeowner to water their own foundation. All Garland water utility customers must follow the Garland water district restrictions on when we can run the sprinklers. April 1 through October 31, customers may water twice per week when using an in-ground sprinkler system. November 1 -March 31, customers may water once per week using an in-ground sprinkler system. Outdoor irrigation between the hours of 10 am and 6 pm is prohibited. This is to prevent excessive evaporation. Watering with a hand-held device, soaker hose or drip irrigation is allowed any time on any day as long as excessive runoff does not occur. At times a person might have to water their own yard if we have maxed out the two times a week schedule from the city. A broken sprinkler head affects all the sprinklers in that zone which means no one gets a good watering so reporting the break to the office or Sheila Raines helps speed the process of repair. Give a glance at your yard to notice repairs needed so they can be fixed promptly.
